

Sharing Files with Apple iCloud Quick Guide



This document will show you how to add files from the vCam Mobile Controller App to the Apple Files app to share them with iCloud.


Using iCloud makes sense because:

- The maximum file size an Email can handle is 25MB.
- The maximum size file you can send by text depends on your carrier.

You can text or email pictures, but you should use a file-share app, like iCloud, to share videos.

We highly recommend you learn how to set up your Files folder and iCloud apps for the best user experience. For example, you should learn how to add and structure folders to keep things organized. 
After you've created your video and JPEG files, disconnect from the control module or reel to free up your Wi-Fi or cellular connection. You cannot send emails or share files while connected to the control module or reel.


